Dear Sam & Cecil;

Sorry I didn't write sooner, but I have been very busy. Besides, there is really nothing I can say. I don't want to talk about this place that I am at now. If I told you anything good about it, it would all be lies, and I shouldn't use language strong enough to describe it in a letter. Believe me Sam, there is nothing as low as a washed out cadet. It isn't bad enough that we washed out, but then they send us down to this hole where they kick you when you try to get up. There are about 4,000 washed out cadets here. I really feel sorry for them. I haven't got it too bad, I am a drill instructor and I drill rookies 8 hours a day. Most of the others draw all the duty details. They are not letting any of us put in for O.C.S. at this post because they claim this is not our permanent post. When we leave and go someplace else it will be the same way. They are short airial [sic] gunners and they figure that since we are all perfect physical specimens we should be gunners. So, I guess we will be gunners.

There is only one out for me as far as I can see but I need your help. I am going to reapply for the cadets. I was just down to see the board and they told me that I would have to get three letters of recommendation [sic] and a copy of my birth certificate. Then I would have to take my examinations over again. I will also have to get  $\frac{1}{3}$  higher in my exams. Then they would have to send my records down to Washington and if they approve I will be reappointed a cadet and will be able to put in for bombardier or navigator.

I want you to get me three good letters of recommendations [sic]. The letters may affect my appointment in Washington. I also want you to get a photostatic copy of my birth certificate. I want you to get them as soon as possible. I may get classified and sent out if I don't get them soon. So send them Special delivery, please.

How is everything at home? How are the kids. Gee, but I would like to get home for a week or so. I could go a good drunk now.

I was going to write to pop tonight, but it is pretty [sic] late and there is really nothing I could write to him the way that I feel now. I received my first letter from him today. I will try to write tomorrow.
