I hope I can get all the papers through before I ship out of here. If not, I will have to apply at my next field. I am going down tomorrow and see if I can go through without my birth certificate. It may work.

I haven't heard from Ed in over a month. Have you? He must be having a heck of a time. I wish I was with him. From the looks of things it will be quite some time before I get a chance though.

I'm going to quit now. I just spoke to one of the fellows and I think Jean is in the U.S.O. show that is here tonight. So, I am going over to see it. It may be her. I haven't heard from her in the past three months.

Tell Pop I wrote you. I will try to write to him tomorrow.
