Hi Gang;

Well it looks like little Harry is off again. Tomorrow I leave for school again. I don't know as yet what school it will be. When I took my aptitude exams they told me that I was qualified for everything they had to offer. I chose radio first and armorer second. Aerial gunnery is included in both courses. Radio is a 24 week course and after you finish that you take five weeks of gunnery and get a staff sargents [sic] rating, or a flight officers warrant which is the same as a third liutenent [sic]. You go through the whole course as a private though. I hope I go to gunnery first because you get a sargents rating when you finish there and I would like to go through radio as a sargent [sic]. They dont [sic] send many to gunnery first through.

I received a letter from Ed yesterday. he didnt [sic] say where he was. He did say that he was on a couple of raids but they werent [sic] very spectacular. One of them did warrant the taking of his name by the U.P. Correspondent where he is and a promise that it would appear in the home town newspaper. keep on the lookout for it.

There isn't [sic] much to write now. I still have quite a bit of packing to do. I am sending out some stuff before I leave here. By the way did you ever recieve [sic] that watch. I will write as soon as I get to my next post. In the meantime write to me it will be forwarded
